

El Camíno de Santíago: Guíded Walk

Porto to Santíago de Compostela



The Camino de Santiago de Compostela though known to be one of the oldest pilgrim routes in the world but in reality is so much more than just that. The Way of St James, as it is also known, is also a personal challenge and a journey of discovery for many. Unchanged for the last 100 years or more, this trip provides to you a journey that is a wonderful way to connect with the local ways and practices, an inspiring journey indeed.

We will be following the last 100 kms of the Camino Portugues from Tui to Santiago de Compostela. This is one of the easiest routes for beginners as it is mainly on flat land. The trip winds its way through woodlands, quaint villages, vineyards, farmlands and historic towns.

Day 1 - 23 September 2019: Arrive in Porto

Arrival in Porto - the transfer to the airport will be provided

The transfer will be provided to all flights arriving between 1100-1130 hours. For all other times, an additional cost will be applicable.

You will be booked for a stay of 1 night at Hotel Vila Gale or similar.

You will have the afternoon to walk around and enjoy this pretty town on your own

Overnight in Porto.

Day 2 - 24 September 2019: Porto to Tui

This morning, after breakfast, we will depart for Tui in Spain – a journey of approx. 3 hours.

You will be booked for a stay of 1 night at Hotel Parador Tui or similar.

Stroll through the picturesque streets of this town; visit the Plaza de San Fernando, the silhouette of the west-facing facade of the 12th-century cathedral will provide you with a lasting memory. Tonight, you will meet the Camino guide who will accompany us for the rest of your trip

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Get an early night as we start our guided walk the next morning.

Day 3 - 25 September 2019: From Tui to O Porrino (16km, 4h)

From the old port of Tui the Camino winds its way up to the old town, following the so-called Camino da Barca. Then through the Tunel das Monxas, the Camino enters a steep section and leads to the evocative bridge of San Telmo. From there, travelling over a much smoother terrain, we come to the town of O Porrino.

You will be booked for a stay of 1 night at **Hotel Expo, O Porrino** or similar. Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Day 4 - 26 September 2019: From O Porrino to Arcade (22km, 5h30)

The terrain becomes easier as you walk across the Louro valley. Keeping the valley to the east, after a gentle climb you arrive at the chapel of Santiaguino de Antas; a pleasant place to take rest. We now enter a wide expanse of woods. Surrounded by pine trees, the Camino starts its descent through the hamlet of Setefontes and reaches Arcade.

You will be booked for a stay of 1 night at **Duarte, Arcade** or similar. Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Day 5 - 27 September 2019: From Arcade to Pontevedra (11km, 3h)

Reaching the historic site of Ponte Sampaio, the Camino crosses the Verdugo River. During the War of Independence, Napoleon's army suffered one of its greatest defeats in Galicia at this bridge. Heading up a cobbled footpath we come to the 13th century church of Santa Maria. Views of the Bay of Vigo are stunning!

You will be booked for a stay of 1 night at **Parador de Pontevedra** or similar. Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Day 6 - 28 September 2019: From Pontevedra to Caldas de Reis (24km, 6h)

Passing chestnut groves, the Camino leaves Pontevedra and runs parallel to the railway for a while. After passing through the hamlet of Ponte Cabras, we encounter the rectory of Santa Maria de Alba, tucked away among pine and eucalyptus trees. Emerging from the dense woods of Lombo da Maceira, you'll see a statue of Saint James the pilgrim, his staff pointing the way to proceed. The lovely village of Tibo, with its fountain, public washing place and stone cross, brings us to Caldas do Rei.

You will be booked for a stay of 1 night at **Torre do Rio, Caldas De Reis** or similar. Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Day 7 - 29 September 2019: From Caldas de Reis to Padron (18km, 4h30)

Exiting the town, we take a bridge over the river Umia that leads us to a fountain of hot spring water that has lent the town its name since Roman times. Entering the woods once more, the Camino make its way gently uphill to the hamlet of Santa Marina. Going downhill, we then cross the river Fontenlo. Finally, following a Camino lined with pine trees, we catch up again with the river as we arrive in Padron. Padron is famous for being the first land sighted by the ship bearing the body of Saint James.

You will be booked for a stay of 1 night at **Hotel Pazo De Lestrove, Padron** or similar. Meals: Breakfast and Dinner

Day 8 - 30 September 2019: From Padron to Santiago (24km, 6h)

The Camino passes through many small villages and hamlets before arriving at the Baroque sanctuary of A Esclavitude. On a hilltop to the left stands the mysterious, abandoned ruins of the hill fort Castro Lupario, and couple of kilometres later, we come to the oldest wayside crosses in Galicia. As we near Agro dos Monteiros, it is now possible to see the towers of the cathedral. Finally the Camino passes by the ruins of a castle known as A Rocha Vella, before entering the city of the Apostle.

You will be booked for a stay of 1 night at **Hotel Parador Reyes Catolicos, Santiago** or similar Meals: Breakfast

Day 9 – 01 October 2019: Santiago de Compostela ; Departure

Santiago de Compostela is a beautiful little Galician town and is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. This morning, you will wander the cobbled streets with your guide and discover its many delights on a short guided walking tour. At noon, you can attend the mass at the Cathedral, one of the main highlights of the El Camino.

Lunch this afternoon will be on your own. Late check out is on request.

This evening, the transfer to the airport will be arranged for you at 1930 hours. For all other times, an additional cost will be applicable.

Meals: Breakfast

Exit from Santiago de Compostela: You can leave Santiago on a flight departing around 2130 hours to either Bilbao, Madrid or Barcelona. Stay the night there and then fly back home the next morning. Or, you can stay another night in Santiago and then fly out, whichever you prefer.
