

Mongolían Odyssey Ulaan Baatar, Gobí Desert, Hustaí National Park



Mongolia is an explorer's dream. This land locked sparsely populated country is known as the "land of the blue sky". It is home to the worlds last surviving nomadic cultures. Travellers will experience incredibly diverse landscapes: from the endless sand dunes across the expanse of the Gobi Desert to the vast grasslands that make up most of Mongolia's terrain. Relatively untouched my modern life, Mongolia is an emerging country and there is no better time than now to visit its unspoiled landscapes and fall in love with this incredible country.

Experience 5 star hotels and local ger camps on this Mongolian Odyssey.

DAY 1 – 3 Sep – Arrive ULAANBAATAR

Meet with our driver and transfer to the for a check-in. You will be booked at the **Hotel Shangri La Ulaan Baatar** for a stay of 2 nights

Afternoon at leisure.

Tonight, enjoy a welcome dinner and tour briefing

Overnight at Hotel Shangri La Ulaan Baatar or similar.

DAY 2 – 4 Sep – ULAANBAATAR SIGHTSEEING

Today we'll have a full day city tour including the Gandan Lamasery, Sukhbaatar Square, the National Museum of Mongolia, Bogd Khan Winter Palace Museum and Zaisan Hill.

Lunch will be in a local restaurant (cost not included)

In the evening, you will enjoy a Mongolian Folk concert followed by dinner.

Overnight at Hotel Shangri La Ulaan Baatar or similar.

DAY 3 – 5 Sep – Fly to SOUTH GOBI AND YOL VALLEY

This morning, an early transfer from the hotel to the airport will be arranges for you.

You will be booked on a domestic flight to the South Gobi (Ömnögobi) town of Dalanzadgad.

Today we'll spend the entire day at the Gurvansaikhan Mountains (The Three Beauties) which gave name to the large national park. We will visit the **Yol Valley** about 90km away and explore this famous ravine, which sometimes has ice and snow. On the ridges around there are sometimes Siberian Ibexes and sometimes we can hear the Altai Snowcock. Lammergeier (*Gypaetus barbatus*) nest on the cliffs and we are almost guaranteed to see them flying over the ravine. Another rare bird is the Wallcreeper (*Tichodroma muraria*) which is also quite easy to see at close range here.

We will also hike a way into the ravine. This hike is through a narrow valley and involves crossing a small stream back and forth. (For those not able to do the entire trek, you can walk only part of it)

We will also stop at the small but interesting museum.

Overnight in the Gobi Desert at Three Camels Lodge or similar.

DAY 4 – 6 Sep - TO BAYANZAG

This morning, after breakfast, we will drive northwest 90km to Bayanzag. The name translates to 'Rich in Saxaul', indicating the 'forests' of salt resistant Saxaul trees (Haloxylon) growing here. These are however mere bushes. The main attraction, though, are the "Flaming Cliffs", made famous by American explorer Roy Chapman Andrews, who here discovered the first ever fossilized dinosaur eggs in the early 1920s. The barren cliffs look strikingly as if they are aflame during sunset.

Overnight in the Gobi Desert at Three Camels Lodge or similar.

DAY5 – 7 Sep - TO HUSTAI NATIONAL PARK

This morning, after breakfast, transfer to the Dalanzadgad airport and fly back to Ulaanbaatar

On arrival, we will head 40 kms west to Hui Doloon Hudag, the grasslands outside the city where the Naadam horse races take place. You will booked at the **HS Khaan Resort or similar** for a stay of 1 night

Lunch will be at the resort. (cost not included)

Afternoon game drive to Hustai National Park where we hope to see many of the free roaming herds of Takhi and see the Przewalski horses in the wild.

Overnight at the **HS Khaan Resort** or similar.

DAY 6 - 8 Sep: BACK TO ULAANBAATAR

Today, we will visit the community groups who inhabit the fringes of Hustai with their livestock. You will have the opportunity to engage with the Hustai buffer zone program where sustainable preservation of the parks unique biodiversity is of utmost importance.

We will enjoy a local lunch of buuz provided by the locals, partners in the conservation of Hustai.

Post lunch, transfer back to Ulaanbaatar after the visit to the local nomad family. Free time in the city.

Dinner tonight will be in a local restaurant.

Overnight in Ulaan Baatar at Hotel Shangri La Ulaan Baatar or similar.

DAY 7 – 9 Sep DEPARTURE

After breakfast, the transfer you to Chinggis Khaan International Airport will be arranged for you for your international flight back home.

BOOKINGS AND PAYMENTS

- 1. A deposit of Rs 20,000 per person will be payable by 31st March 2019. If paying by cheque, please make the cheque payable to Odyssey Tours & Travels.
- 2. At the time of making the booking, please send a copy of the first page of your passport
- 3. Balance payment is to be made by 3^{rd} May 2019.
- 4. All rates are subject to a revision if there is a fluctuation in the currency rates.

CANCELLATION & REFUNDS

- 1. Should you wish to amend/ cancel any part of a confirmed booking / reservation all such cancellations must be advised in writing. Given below is the cancellation policy.
- 2. Payment of the booking deposit constitutes acceptance of our terms and conditions.
- Cancellation of a reservation due to any visa being rejected will amount to cancellation charges being levied as per the scale mentioned below and Odyssey Tours & Travels will not be responsible for any visa rejection by the respective consulates.
- 4. Cancellation of any reservations are subject to the following conditions:
 - a. Cancellations effected after booking will attract a service fee of Rs 5000 pp.
